- The hard copy form can be submitted at the school
- To apply please make sure you attached all the necessary document for the child: certified copy of the child birth certificate, school leaving report (copy can also be made from the school N\$ 1-00 per copy)
- Registration fee upon bringing the form is N\$100-00 once off and non-refundable.

School development fund

- Every child is required to contribute N\$400-00 for school development fund per year

Due date: 30 September 2026

Note

- Parents wishing to pay school fee once for year or semester are urged to contact the school principal.
- December payments must always made before or on the last day of school.

Uniforms requirements

- Parents are expected to order a set of school uniform with the school which is 50% deposit upon ordering.
- All learners are expected to wear full uniform from the beginning of the year, however if a parents place the order with the school (uniforms are ordered from **Dinapama** and the order take 3-4 months)
- No child will be allowed to attend classes without uniforms

- If you place an order a child can wear as follows: (from pep)

Girls: navy blue skirt and light blue t-shirt

Boys: Navy blue trouser and light blue t-shirt

- Black or navy blue school bag

NB: all shirts from PEP should have a school log, contact the school to direct you who can put the school log for you on your own cost.

Summer uniforms

1. **Boys:** navy blue shorty (from pep) or school uniform shorty with a school golf t-shirt, grey/ black socks and black uniform shoes
2. **Girls:** navy blue skirt or shorty (from pep) or school uniform shorty with school golf t-shirt, grey/ black socks and black uniform shoes
